

**THERE IS NOTHING** "junior" about this dreamy bedroom suite by Jeff Lincoln of Jeff Lincoln Interiors, who grew up with an interior designer father and has followed in his footsteps. "Periodically, God appears to me!" Lincoln says, laughing. "Actually, I felt a huge freedom doing this junior master suite, where I still believe the maximum stay should be three days," he says, echoing common folk wisdom. "But it still adheres to my design philosophy of comfortable chic. There's a clean, appealing juxtaposition of color and pattern that works well here. It's a little classic and a little beach mixed together."

The navy-colored wallpaper that so clearly identifies this room is from Lincoln's close friend Lulu de Kwiatkowski of Lulu DK. "I was in Lulu's studio one day and I saw her working on this paper," Lincoln recalls. "I knew right there and then that I wanted to be the first to use it. I don't normally like using thematic clichés like corals and shells at a beach house, but Lulu had totally reinvented the concept and had turned it into a much better thing."

The Lulu DK fabrics and wall coverings are available from Hinson & Co., who took their first order from Lincoln's father years ago. "It's nice to have that continuum within this business," he notes. "Harry Hinson has been a mentor to me, and I'm thrilled to be using his products here." Lincoln softened the impact of the wallpaper by using equally strong elements, such as striped bedding and brightly colored upholstery pieces as on the linen that covers the bench and sofa. The effect is a bold, unforgettable space.
